Bong Lian 连文豪 is a Professor at Brandeis University in Boston, Massachusetts. He completed his PhD in Physics at Yale University in 1991. He was a postdoctoral fellow at the University of Toronto, and later at Harvard University. He joined the Brandeis Mathematics faculty in 1995, and has remained there since. Professor Lian's research is at the interface between Mathematics and Physics, and has been interested in questions about the geometry of a class of spaces known as Calabi-Yau manifolds. His research interests also include representation theory and string theory. Professor Lian will be teaching Linear Algebra at Mathcamp this summer.
